Commercial Manure Applicator Certification/Recertification JANUARY 5, 2007

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This course is for commercial manure service managers and commercial manure service representatives who apply manure for a fee.

This course will qualify as initial certification and as recertification for commercial manure service representatives. Confinement site applicators may also attend, but will be required to attend all three hours of the program versus the required two hours in the confinement site program.

Applicators are highly encouraged to attend this satellite program due to the uncertainty of when videotapes will be available for training in late January and February 2007.

All commercial licenses expire on March 1, annually.

FEES FOR 2007

Again in 2007, commercial manure services (businesses) must be licensed. Each commercial manure service must name a manager whose certification fees will be covered under the \$200 license fee for the business. Commercial manure service representatives (employees) must be associated with a commercial manure service. The representative's certification fee is \$75. Additional fees will include an annual \$25 educational fee assessed to all employees and the manager. These fees have remained the same for 2007.

INITIAL CERTIFICATION

New employees of a commercial manure service who are not yet certified can apply manure for the first 30 days of employment after they are hired, if they are supervised by a certified commercial manure applicator. After 30 days, new employees must be certified. New commercial applicators may become certified at any time during the year. All certificates will expire on March 1 annually, no matter when you become initially certified.

RECERTIFICATION

All currently certified commercial manure service representatives have certificates that will expire on March 1, 2007, and applications for certification in 2007 must be postmarked by March 1, 2007, to avoid paying the late fee of \$12.50 (New applicators, who have never been certified, are exempt from the late fee). After March 1, any previously certified commercial manure applicator cannot apply manure until they have attended training or passed the exam and sent in their application for renewal and fee.

In 2007, commercial applicators can initially certify or recertify in one of three ways:

- Attend the satellite downlink workshop scheduled for January 5, 2007 at your local county extension office (see list on right);
- Watch a three-hour training video by scheduling an appointment at your local Iowa State University Extension County Office, or
- Take and pass the certification exam. Exams can be scheduled at regional DNR field offices.

In addition to completing one of the three requirements listed above, commercial applicators must submit the application for certification and the appropriate fee to the IDNR.
