

Commercial Manure Applicator Certification – January 6, 2010

Iowa State University Extension in cooperation with Iowa Department of Natural Resources, will present the Commercial Manure Applicator Certification/Recertification on Wednesday, January 6, 2010, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Commercial manure applicators must be certified on an annual basis and the company must be licensed annually. Commercial manure services and representatives must be certified regardless of the source of the manure (confinement or open feedlot) or the size of operation. The following counties are hosting the program.

Who should attend?

This course will qualify as initial certification and recertification for commercial manure service representatives and managers.

All commercial licenses expire on March 1.

Commercial applicators unable to attend this workshop can schedule time at their county extension office to watch the video/webcast. Due to scheduling conflicts, walk-ins are no longer accepted. Please call to schedule your training. Anyone not able to attend training should schedule an appointment with their DNR field office to take the certification exam.
